Isaiah 9:1-7

“Light”

Isaiah 9:1-2

1. Nevertheless, there will be no more gloom for those who were in distress. In the past he humbled the land of Zebulun and the land of Naphtali, but in the future he will honor Galilee of the Gentiles, by the way of the sea, along the Jordan — 2. The people walking in darkness have seen a great light; on those living in the land of the shadow of death a light has dawned.

Matthew 4:12-14

12. When Jesus heard that John had been put in prison, he returned to Galilee. 13. Leaving Nazareth, he went and lived in Capernaum, which was by the lake in the area of Zebulun and Naphtali— 14. to fulfill what was said through the prophet Isaiah:

Isaiah 9:3-5

3. You have enlarged the nation and increased their joy; they rejoice before you as people rejoice at the harvest, as men rejoice when dividing the plunder. 4. For as in the day of Midian's defeat, you have shattered the yoke that burdens them, the bar across their shoulders, the rod of their oppressor. 5. Every warrior's boot used in battle and every garment rolled in blood will be destined for burning, will be fuel for the fire.
