Ten Essentials for “Love and Happiness”

1. Christ must be at the center of every relationship!

Matthew 6:33

But seek first his kingdom and his righteousness, and all these things will be given to you as well.

Psalms 127:1

2. Commitment to God and family first!

Matthew 19:4-5

A cheerful heart is a good medicine,


