A few trusted souls

People with vision or who want something themselves
People who have loyalty to visionary
People who are secure in themselves
People who know how to keep their mouths shut
People who also know when to speak up
People who are secure in their relationship with leader
People who have their own relationship with God
People who have identifiable gifts

Ministry of a few trusted souls

Help with strategy

Encourage heart of leader

Provide various resources

Assist in articulating and cascading the vision

Initial group may not be established leadership
